

FIXES & ENHANCEMENTS

- Improved the bulk emailing feature by incorporating a new “Email Outbox”. The “Send” buttons of the output configurators will now send all outgoing email messages to this new “outbox” (instead of attempting to immediately send out each email). The new Email Outbox screen allows the user to more clearly see the emails that are being sent out (and to preview them if desired before sending). It also provides an excellent tool for troubleshooting email messages whose delivery fails and incorporates auto-retry logic that will continue to send failed emails until a successful delivery is achieved. We’ve also added an optional feature to the new Email Outbox that will log to a text file the details about each email message successfully sent out by the outbox.
- Fixed problem with the phone number fields on the Individual Detail Form where the ###-###-#### format was being applied even when the user had selected “No Formatting” under the Regional Settings screen.
- Fixed problem with Individual Profile Reports where certain milestone data were not being displayed properly.
- Fixed problem with the “Membership” tab of the Dashboard screen where the listing of upcoming Birthdays and Wedding Anniversaries was included deceased individuals.
- Fixed a problem with the Individual Profile Report where it would generate a “3265 : Item not found in this collection” error message when creating a profile report for a deceased individual.
- Added the text “[Deceased]” to the top of the Individual Detail Form if the currently displayed individual has been marked as deceased.
- Fixed problem with the Dashboard screen’s “Print” button for the Birthday and Wedding Anniversary lists where the day of the week shown on the report next to the birthday or anniversary was showing the day of the week of the actual original birthdate or wedding date - not the next occurrence.
- Fixed the “An expression in argument 2 has an invalid value” error that occurred upon opening any of the Detail View forms if they had been closed when the form was extending beyond the top of the screen (i.e. off the top edge of the screen).
- On all output configurators having an “Email” tab, added a “Copy to Clipboard” button to the “Email Recipient List” form (viewable by clicking the “View Recipients” button) so that the user can copy all of the target email addresses to the Windows Clipboard (which then could be pasted into another program).
- Fixed a problem with the Import Utility when importing individual records where it would fail after importing the first record.
- Fixed a problem with the “Exports” tab of the Household Output Configurator where an error would occur during the export process when using the “Name & Email Address Only” option along with a filter (i.e. specifying a filter criteria on the “Filter” tab).
- Fixed problem with the Health & Statistics snapshot report where a “No current record” error was being displayed when reporting on the first week of the calendar year.
- Fixed problem with the “Contributions Summary - Pledged vs Non-Pledged” Contributions Utility report where it was not handling correctly contributions where the Pledge Month/Year values were different from the Month & Year of the Payment Date.
- Fixed problem with the Contributors With No Contributions utility report where the “Total Contrib during 12 months prior to Last Contrib” value was incorrect (was showing all prior contributions).
- Modified the Date value shown at the top of the Contribution Batch Detail Form and the Pay Date field in the detail list control (at the bottom of the form) to use the CH2010 Regional Settings date format. Previously these fields were using the Windows date format setting - which might be different than the CH2010 Regional Settings date format.
- Fixed problem with the Contribution statements and Pledge statements where the pledge status tables were occasionally getting broken (split) across page breaks.
- Improved the error message shown to the user when trying to email a contribution statement to a specific contributor if there is no email address stored in the database for that contributor.
- Fixed problem with the Contribution Batch Detail Form where a “13 : Type Mismatch” error message was being shown when the user cleared out the Quid Pro Quo field.

- Fixed problem when generating Meeting Roll Call reports for multiple meetings where page breaks were not being inserted correctly when the “Include visitor write-in lines” and “Include Manual Counts write-in lines” checkboxes were left unchecked.
- Fixed problem with the Meeting Roll Call reports where headers were getting cut off if the names of the group leaders could not fit onto a single line at the top of the report.
- Fixed problem with the Meeting Roll Call Report Configurator where the “Header Text” and “Header Logo” pull-down field selections were not being saved and always defaulted to “Primary” and “Large”.
- Fixed problem where a “2100 : The control or subform control is too large for this location” error message was displayed when minimizing the Contribution Batch Detail and Meeting Detail forms.
- Fixed problem in the Custom Report Generator where a “3085 : Undefined function” error was being generated when including the “Birthday (mm/dd)” or “Wedding Anniversary (mm/dd)” fields in Step 3 of the CRG.
- Fixed problem in the Custom Report Generator with Contributions as the Data Source where including the “Tax Deductible” field would cause an “Enter Parameter Value” prompt to be displayed and the field’s data in the output would be incorrect.
- Fixed problem in the MS Outlook Export Utility where the items in the filter pull-down controls were not alphabetically sorted.
- Fixed problem on the Contact Detail Form where initially upon opening the form the “Env#” field had a white background instead of a grey field background (to visually indicate the field is locked).
- Fixed a problem when creating directories with the Group Membership Output Configurator when using the “2 Group” option and using the “Include Option” #2 where under certain conditions either an “Invalid use of null” error would be generated or there might be entries in the directory listed as “Invalid”.
- Improved the installation package by reducing the chances of conflicts when installing system DLL and OCX files.
- Added an “MDE info” button to the program’s About screen to show the exact location and version of the CHMOD10.mde file.
- Move the location of the CHMOD10.mde file to the program’s installation folder rather than the Windows “System32” folder for better installation compatibility.
- Fixed problem with the customfrontend.mdb file provided by the program’s installer where it was referencing a CH2008 data file instead of a CH2010 data file.
